## Recipe of the month

Rainbow Chicken Pilaf Recipe

Makes: 6

Ingredients

1 tsp Extra virgin olive oil

1 Brown onion, finely diced

650g Chicken

1 tsp Ginger, minced

1 tsp Garam masala, ground

1 tsp Cinnamon, ground

1 tsp Turmeric, ground

1 3/4 Cup Basmati rice, uncooked

1L Chicken stock, salt reduced

1 Carrot, diced

3 stalks Celery, diced

1 Capsicum

1 Cup Frozen Peas

Summer veggies to serve

Method

Heat a drizzle of olive oil in a large fry pan.

Add onions and stir until softened.

Add the chicken pieces and fry until the chicken pieces start to brown.

Add garam masala, cinnamon and turmeric, carrot, celery and uncooked rice to the pan. Stir for a

couple of minutes until rice is yellow.

Pour in the stock and add capsicum and peas.

Bring to the boil, lower the heat, then cover the pan with a lid.

Cook until rice is cooked and stock is absorbed.

Serve chicken pilaf with seasonal vegetables.
